The **FIRST** Saint Bernard to be registered at the American Kennel Club (AKC) was a male named CHIEF AKC #3280. The **FIRST** bitch was Alma AKC #3282. Saints first showed up in the AKC Stud Book Volume II 1885. Of the first six registered, five were owned by Miss Anna H. Whitney of Lancaster, MA.
