Cindy is the FIRST Saint Bernard to become a CH UDT and we must confess we are very proud of her.

As a puppy, Cindy was very impressive and was chosen as pick-of-the-litter of 10 pups. She was also puppy tested for obedience. The first time shown she not only won breed over 20 other puppies, but also won the Working Group at 4 months of age. She also won Best of Breed at a Specialty Match over approximately 40 Saints when 9 months of age.

The first points Cindy won was a 3-point major under P. Knoop. A week later she went WB and BW for 2 additional points. Shortly after that, she was bred and had a litter of 10 beautiful puppies. She wasn't shown in conformation extensively for a long time because of obedience work.

The first obedience match Cindy was in, she won High In Trial, which was repeated at several matches. Her Companion Dog (CD) was earned in November 1971, with all scores of over 190.

Open work started immediately and a Companion Dog Excellent (CDX) was earned in November of 1972. On the way to earning her CDX, she went High In Trial at the Ohio SBC Trial with a score of 198.5.

There was a slight pause between Open and Utility for her puppies. When showing in Utility, Cindy placed each time she qualified.

Tracking started after Utility and that title was earned on October 4, 1975, at Blennerhassett KC Tracking Test, making Cindy the 3rd Utility Dog Tracking (UDT) Saint Bernard in the history of the breed. In the meantime she had been showing in the breed ring at a few shows and needed only a major to finish her championship. At Muncie, IN, on February 1, 1976, Cindy went WB and BW over a total of 40 Saints under J. Neff. This finished her championship, thus the First CH UDT in the history of the breed. All points and titles were earned owner-handled.
