Summer came to us at the age of 8 weeks. She was a busy puppy, always willing to try anything. At 6 months of age she pulled at the SBC of Puget Sound's Oktoberfest and won the Jungen Title. The pull was stopped at 1600lbs and Summer's time was the fastest. Summer exhibited the proper pulling style from the very beginning and was a natural.

The Club began recording times, weights and percentages for weight pulls the early part of 1988. By June of that year Summer had already achieved the Weight Puller (WP) and Weight Puller Excellent (WPX) titles.

The SBC of America held their first weight pull at the National Specialty in June of 1988. Summer won her weight division and Best Percentage pulling 16.4 times her weight. She went on to achieve the **first** ever Weight Puller Superior (WPS) title.

Summer lived to be 12 years old and was always very special to us. She produced two Specialty winning Champion get, and was the foundation of many more.
