I was introduced to Dudley in late 1992. I had just lost a nice bitch and, being heartbroken, I called Joan and Stan Zielinski and asked them if they had anything available. Yes, they had a 3- year-old male who was returned to them after the owner's husband was killed and the wife just found out she had cancer. I raced to Seattle to find, to my horror, a half mask. I was completely prejudiced against anything but perfectly marked specimens, but Stan just said, "Don't look at that side." I could tell Dudley had a great personality so off we went. I did finally grow accustomed to his face, so to speak.

Dudley earned his CD with 3 High In Trial (HIT) wins, one of them from the SBC of America's (SBCA) National Specialty in Utah in October 1993. He also earned his Draft Dog title at that same National. Two months later, we went to Canada and he earned his Canadian CD in a four-show weekend with four qualifying scores, three in the 190s.

The next National was the following May so we really scrambled to get ready for Open A. In the meantime, we continued to do weight pulling and train for agility. He pulled 3,380 pounds at only his fourth weight pull. Dudley didn't qualify in Open A at the National or any of the cluster shows but he did pass the draft test again.

Following that National, Dudley competed in an AKC agility trial and won fourth place with a perfect score in the Novice A class with 65 entries. By now, I was convinced that the dog would try anything! Agility was our favorite sport. He never qualified again because he wasn't a great jumper.

We spent the summer getting ready for more Open A competition and he got his CDX in October of 1994, the day after he earned his breed championship. The following month, we drove to Canada and he got his Canadian CDX in a three-show weekend. I was so grateful to him that we wouldn't have to make another 1,000 mile round trip! We competed in Open B in a few more shows and he picked up two more specialty HITs for a total of five in his lifetime.

Dudley's highest weight pulled in his lifetime was 3,400 pounds. In 1995, he earned the IWPA Region 2 Gold Medal for snow. Three days before his 8th birthday, he won the weight pull at the 1997 SBCA National in Colorado Springs with energy to spare. It brought tears to my eyes as well as many of the spectators.

Besides being a great competitor, Dudley has been a terrific companion. Kids love him and he can't help slobbering all over them and leaning on them until they fall down, laughing. Dudley is also nuts about cats. He has had two good cat friends who let him slobber all over them as they rub against him. One of them used to knead his claws in Dudley's fur.

Dudley's favorite thing, even above food, is stuffed toys. We have been through dozens of Chew-Man toys because he loves to play tug-of-war with them. One of my favorite stories about him happened at a dog show where we were sitting around after competing in Novice B up in Washington. A lady with a Golden Retriever was sitting next to us and she gave her dog a stuffed toy. The dog had the toy in his mouth and teasingly strutted up to Dudley, who was lying down watching the goings-on. With incredible speed, Dudley leapt up, grabbed the toy from the Golden's mouth and lay down again in the same spot with his prize.
