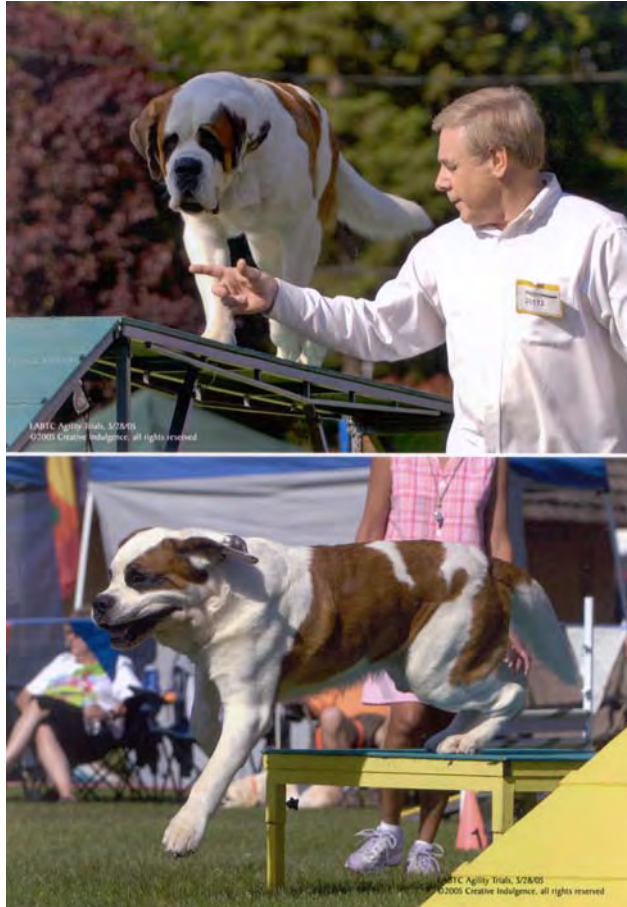

He needed one qualifying run in the Open Standard Preferred class to complete his OAP title, and two qualifying runs in the Open Jumpers Preferred class to complete his OJP title.

On Saturday, November 29th, Kris qualified in both the Open Standard and Jumpers classes, or, as they say in agility, he double Qd. The Open Standard Preferred qualifying run earned Kris his OAP title and thus made him the first champion to earn an advanced agility title.

Kris and his Pembroke Welsh Corgi sister, Ms Lina UD NAP OJP, were off to Dairy Queen for hamburgers and ice cream cones to celebrate!
