Mistihil Stormy Weather by Rowdy lives up to her name. She is the fastest, smartest, and most agile St. Bernard I've ever had the pleasure of meeting. She is super confident, thinks for herself as her breed was bred to do, and when she's connected to her handler, she is a super Rally Obedience dog. She exhibited that the day after she earned (barely, with a score of only 70) her Rally Novice title under Judge Jill K Jones at the Inland Empire Collie Club's All-Breed trial. When we got her title picture, Jill, with her charming British accent admitted to me that she thought she had gotten a little soft at the end of a very long day of judging when she gave Stormy that qualifying score. The next day we were privileged to show under her again and Stormy qualified with a very respectable 92, earning 3rd place in a very large Rally Novice class.

A few weeks later we move up to Rally Intermediate and she earned her title in just 3 shows, becoming the first St. Bernard to earn the Rally Intermediate title.

For those of you that aren't super familiar with Rally Obedience and its history, Rally Intermediate was introduced the year we earned that title as an optional titling class that includes all the Rally Advanced signs except the jumps, but is performed on-lead instead of off-lead.

Stormy loved showing in Rally Intermediate so much that we continued showing in that class (and sometimes in Advanced too) for a whole year before we finally qualified in Advanced – We had some nerves to work through, and Stormy definitely provided the amusement for many spectators for a while there by insisting on playing with her lead in the ring, using that as a stress relief mechanism.

We're now on our way to more advanced classes and Stormy hopefully has a long and illustrious career as a performance and show dog ahead of her, having since achieved her WPX title, pulling 3080 lbs. in one performance the same day she ran 20.5 mph in a Fast CAT title, as the 2nd St. Bernard to achieve a BCAT title. We are very fortunate to have this loving, athletic, smart dog in our lives, as she works as a Mobility and PTSD Service Dog for Allison and competes with me.
