

With Matt's guidance first thing Sully and I did with the AKC was get CGC and TKN. It was at the North East Grand Slam in 2018. It was so amazing to see all the saints and be able to bring mine there to get their first titles.

Along the way, we discovered so much more. However, dock diving is Sully's true passion. Within a couple weeks of training, he was flying off the dock. He actually was jumping for feathers for the first couple months. I had to transition him to be motivated enough for a regular bumper. In June 2020, he became the first Saint Bernard to get his Dock Senior title. This title requires 5 jumps between 15' and 19'11". He received it at Central K9 in Storrs, CT.
