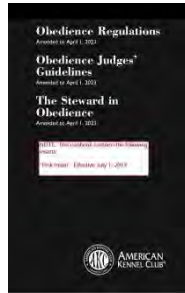

On the AKC website is the new updated version of the **AKC Obedience Regulations**. The pdf file is now available to download.

I have downloaded that file to my desktop, opened it up to **highlight** & underline many, many items which help me find topics quickly. It is somewhat color coded to track items instead of looking at pages of black text. This *hybrid working model pdf* works better *for me* to do a quick review of important Chapters and Sections I may need to review for specifics prior to judging, or in finding data for answering questions. I have shared my “working pdf” in the past and there were quite a few requests for a copy.

I now have my updated **highlighted** & underlined copy of the AKC Obedience Regulations pdf available to download, if you may find it of interest.
